

**Call for Nomination for IEEE ComSoc
Industrial Innovation Award
for the Europe, Middle East,
and Africa Region**

The “IEEE Communications Society Industrial Innovation Award for the Europe, Middle East, and Africa Region” is sponsored by the IEEE Europe Middle East and Africa (EMEA) Region. This award honors individuals at any level who were industry employees and have achieved major industrial accomplishments that are of substantial benefit to the public in the field of communications and information technologies and visible beyond the company or institution where the contribution was made.

- ❖ Applicants must be an IEEE ComSoc member, and resident in the EMEA Region.
- ❖ The “IEEE ComSoc Industrial Researcher Award for the EMEA Region” will be awarded to the best candidate.

Award Prize

- ❖ The recipient of “IEEE ComSoc Industrial Researcher Award for the EMEA Region” will receive a certificate and honorarium of US\$600.

Selection Process

An EMEA Selection Committee will determine the award recipient from among the eligible applicants.

Each nominator or applicant must submit an Application to the Chair of the IEEE ComSoc EMEA Industrial Innovation Award Committee before the deadline.

Applications should include the following:

- ❖ Applicant’s biography.
- ❖ Description of main topics/achievements/products of the applicant over the last three years. (A4 one page)
- ❖ The cover page should contain the applicant's name, affiliation, address, IEEE Membership Number, ComSoc membership, telephone, fax number and e-mail address.

- ❖ 31 August 2024: *Closing date for Submissions*
- ❖ 27 October 2024: *Announcement of Awardees*
