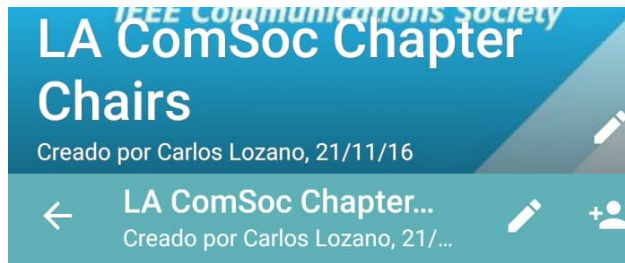

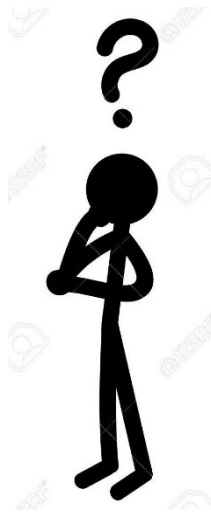
- ◆ Faster communication between members
